



**SALES EVENTS AND GARAGE SALE SIGNS
REQUIRE REGISTRATION**

Just a reminder to all Business Owners and Citizens of Hudson, that all temporary signs, such as “garage” sales or other “event” signs must be registered before installing or posting the sign. Section 1207.17 of the Land Development Code requires all temporary signs to be registered with the Department of Community Development. Registration forms are located on line at www.hudson.oh.us and also at the Community Development Office located at 46 Ravenna Street, Suite D-3, in the Evaporator Works. Below are the requirements from the Land Development Code:

- 1) Please check size requirement and number of signs below for your district.
- 2) For garage sale, temporary sign only permitted on property where the sale is being held.
- 3) Temporary sign not permitted on street corners/intersections.
- 4) Temporary sign to be located on the property 15 feet from street pavement. This will keep the sign out of the City Right-of-Way.

<u>District</u>	<u>Maximum Number of Signs</u>	<u>Total Area Allowed for All Signs</u>
Residential Districts (1-2-3-4)	2	Temporary Sign – 10 square feet
Commercial District (5)	2	Temporary Sign – 10 square feet
Office Industrial Districts (6-8)	4	Temporary Sign – 32 square feet
Commercial Districts (7 - 9)	2	Temporary Sign – 20 square feet
Ravenna Road Corridor District (10)	2	Temporary Sign – 20 square feet
