

City of Hudson Cemeteries

Grave Site Regulations:

1. Artificial flowers are NOT permitted at any time. Fresh, cut flowers are always welcome, but glass containers are prohibited.
2. Green-only artificial wreaths are permitted from December 1 to February 2.
3. Balloons and other inappropriate decorations are subject to immediate removal.
4. American flags and Veterans/DAR medallions are welcome.
5. Potted plants are permitted, but will be removed by cemetery personnel when they no longer serve a decorative purpose.
6. No plantings by individuals are permitted in the Memorial Section where only flush-mounted markers are allowed.
7. Plantings are permitted in the AISLES ONLY of other sections of the cemeteries, and are subject to the approval of cemetery authorities. Specific permission regarding types of plantings and exact locations will be accommodated as much as possible.
8. Copings (edges of rock, brick, plastic wood and metal) are not permitted around grave sites.

General Regulations:

1. All burials and foundation preparation must be done under the supervision of the cemetery sexton.
2. Vaults are mandatory for full burials. They are preferred for cremations.
3. Up to three interments of ashes will be permitted in one grave site. However, if individual commemorative markers are desired for multiple burials, they must be flush-mounted.
4. Visitations are only permitted during daylight hours. Non-authorized individuals found in Hudson cemeteries after dark are subject to prosecution for criminal trespass.
5. Except by descent, no sale or transfer of a grave site shall be effective unless ratified by the City of Hudson.
