Mr. Wash called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Markillie cemetery.

Mr. Wash asked for approval of previous minutes.

Old Business

Mr. Wash shared that there was no progress in finding a qualified contractor to bid within the budgeted amount. The city will still pursue new bids.

The finance report was still favorable and above forecasted revenue.

Mr. Wash said the remains found at the Reserve of River Oaks were interred in June. The marker will be installed later this year.

Staff is still working on replacing failing signage and will look to replace for the 2023 year.

Mr. Wash inquired about the fall evening event. Several dates were discussed. The board will look at calendars and get back with feasible dates to plan for. The selected cemetery to highlight would be Draper.

New Business

Mr. Wash indicated that the Regular Part time position has not been filled.

Memorial Day. Mr. Wash shared that the Memorial Day Parade and activity in the cemetery was a success. The Friends of Hudson Parks assisted by installing the annual flowers in the memorial section.

Mr. Wash conveyed that contractors have stated the stone wall in front of Markillie is failing and may need replaced in the coming years. Mr. Sorgi commented that we could see if local donors would assist financially with the project.

Mr. Wash shared that more driveway paving will be performed next year and that after the renovations at Old Hudson Township Burying Ground that needs at O'Brien and Markillie will be addressed.

Mr. Wash adjourned the meeting at 6:05pm
