Subject: Changes to items within the original RFP as specified in this Addendum.

The purpose of ADDENDUM NO. 3 is to list changes to the REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL – RESIDENTIAL REFUSE AND RECYCLING SERVICES for the City of Hudson, Ohio as stated below.

Original:

Page 2 – Item A. PURPOSE “Bidders will provide pricing as instructed for each of the three (3) service options listed above.”

Page 7 – Item H. Containers “The recycle container shall have a capacity of sixty-five (65) gallons and have a distinctive color and recycling markings, including a recycling sticker, to indicate acceptable items.”

Page 11 – Item E. NUMBER OF RESIDENTS (CUSTOMERS) PARTICIPATING “... Contractor, as required by City of Hudson Codified Ordinances, Chapter 848, will provide quarterly reports of number of participating households for refuse collection and actual count of recycling carts picked-up weekly.

Page 11 – Item F. REFUSE HAULER PROGRAM “... This bid requires bid pricing for each of the three (3) options be submitted for the City to consider.”

Page 13 – Item L. CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEE REQUIREMENTS “... Contractor, upon execution of the contract, shall provide the City with the names of all persons who will be performing collection services within the City and, during the term of the Contract, Contractor shall promptly notify the City of any additions, changes or deletions thereto or there from.”

“... Contactor shall provide the City of Hudson a list of Employees working in the City of Hudson and Supervisor Contact information.”

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Page 18 – Item DD. OPERATION OF COLLECTION PROGRAMS

1. Garbage, Rubbish, Yard Waste Pickup
 - c. “Unlimited number of containers.”

Page 19 – Item DD. OPERATION OF COLLECTION PROGRAMS

2. Recyclables Pickup
 - k. “Proof of recycling must be provided to the Public Works Department. As per the City of Hudson Codified Ordinances, Chapter 848, Contractor must provide quarterly recycling reports.
 - 1) Quarterly reports should indicate an accurate count of residents using the recycling services, not estimates based on ability to recycle.
 - 2) Contractor should provide the City with an actual count of the number of recycling carts distributed to residents every six (6) months.”

Addendum No. 3:

Page 2 – Item A. PURPOSE “Bidders are not required to bid upon all three (3) service options, but must provide pricing as instructed for each of the service options bid upon.”

Page 7 – Item H. Containers “The recycle container shall have a capacity of sixty-five (65) gallons and have a distinctive color and recycling markings. Residents will be made aware of acceptable items via a flyer provided by the Contractor, and to be included with their bill(s).”

Page 11 – Item E. NUMBER OF RESIDENTS (CUSTOMERS) PARTICIPATING “... Contractor, as required by City of Hudson Codified Ordinances, Chapter 848, will provide quarterly reports of number of participating households and tonnage collected for each refuse and recycling collection.

Page 11 – Item F. REFUSE HAULER PROGRAM “... This Request for Proposal does not require submission of bid pricing for all of the three (3) service options. However, submitted bids must include complete pricing for each of the service options bid upon for the City to consider.”

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Page 13 – Item L. CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEE REQUIREMENTS “... Contractor, upon execution of the Contract, shall provide the City with the name(s) of a Supervisor who may be contacted regarding all persons who perform collections services within the City.

“... Contactor shall provide the City of Hudson with Supervisor contact information.”

Page 18 – Item DD. OPERATION OF COLLECTION PROGRAMS

1. Garbage, Rubbish, Yard Waste Pickup
 - c. “Reasonable number of containers.”

Page 19 – Item DD. OPERATION OF COLLECTION PROGRAMS

2. Recyclables Pickup
 - k. “Proof of recycling must be provided to the Public Works Department. As per the City of Hudson Codified Ordinances, Chapter 848, Contractor must provide quarterly recycling reports.”
