

Is it an ash tree?

Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) only eats ash!

Identify an ash tree:

- Compound, odd leaves with 7-11 leaflets
- Branches and buds are opposite with a single bud at the end of the branch
- Gray bark, diamond shaped furrows
- Seeds like maple



Branch and leaf arrangements
are opposite

Odd-pinnately
compound leaves
